

## **Guest Follow-Up**

- 4. Actually follow up with them.Visitor letter or email thanking them for coming.A call from you, maybe midweek.A post card inviting them to take the next step.
- 5. Have something to connect them to their next step. Growth Track, Pastor's breakfast or lunch, something...
